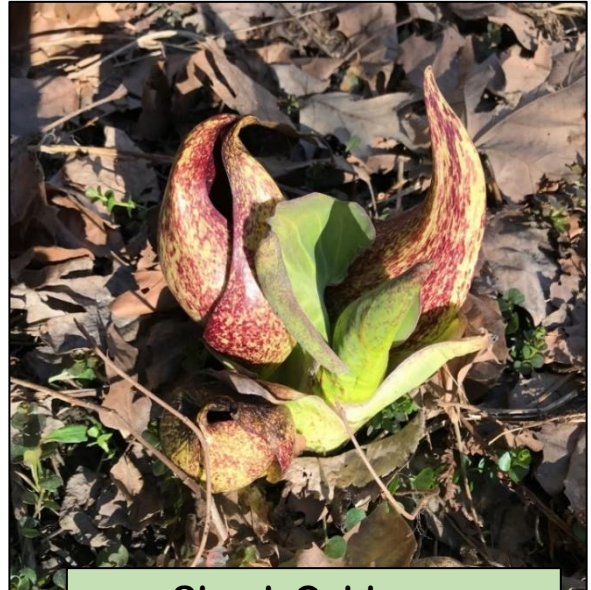

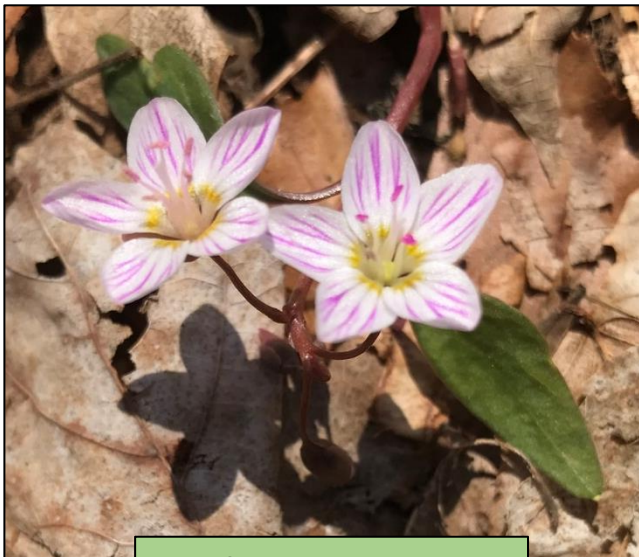

As temperatures rise in April, we look forward to seeing the early spring wildflowers. But it's been so long since we've seen them last... what are their names? Who should we be looking for?

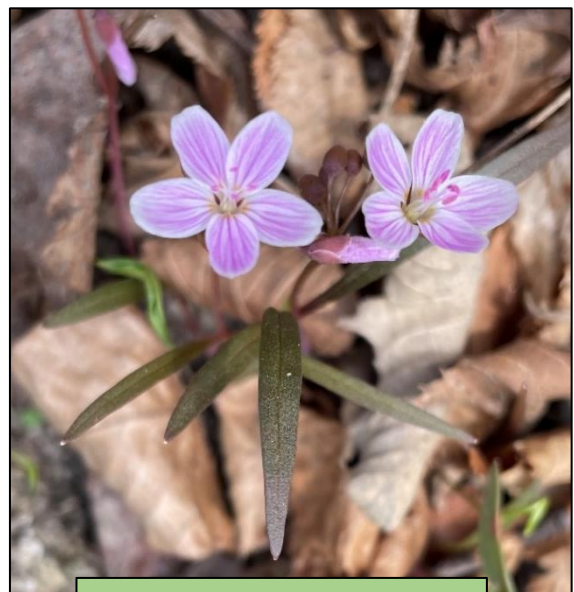
A quick guide to those joyful wonders of early spring!

Lily family

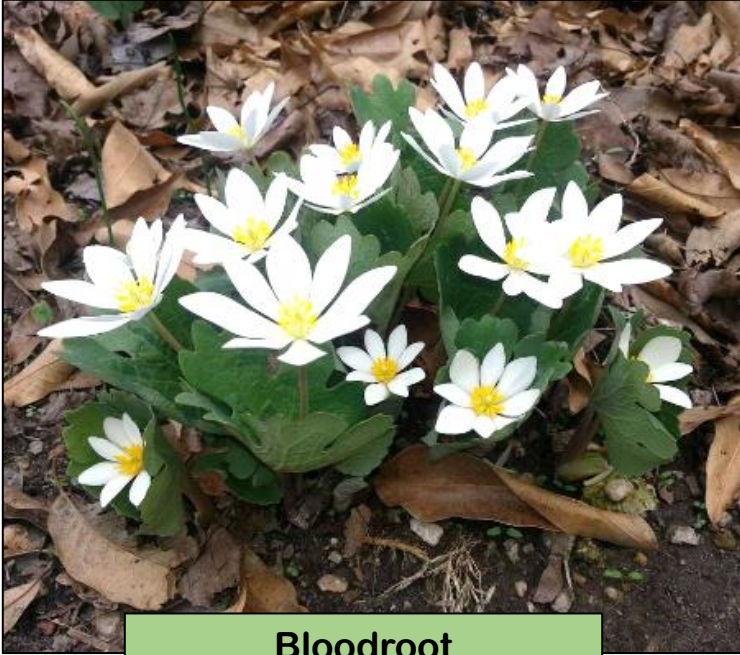


**Large White Trillium**

Borage family

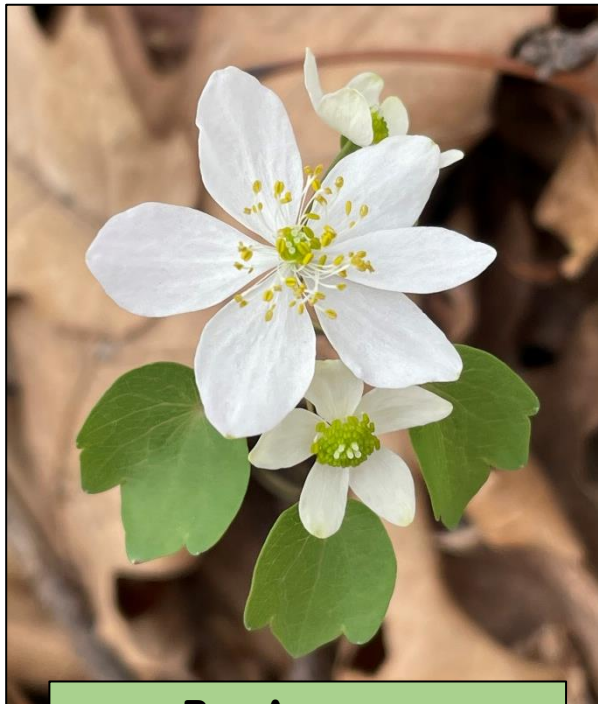




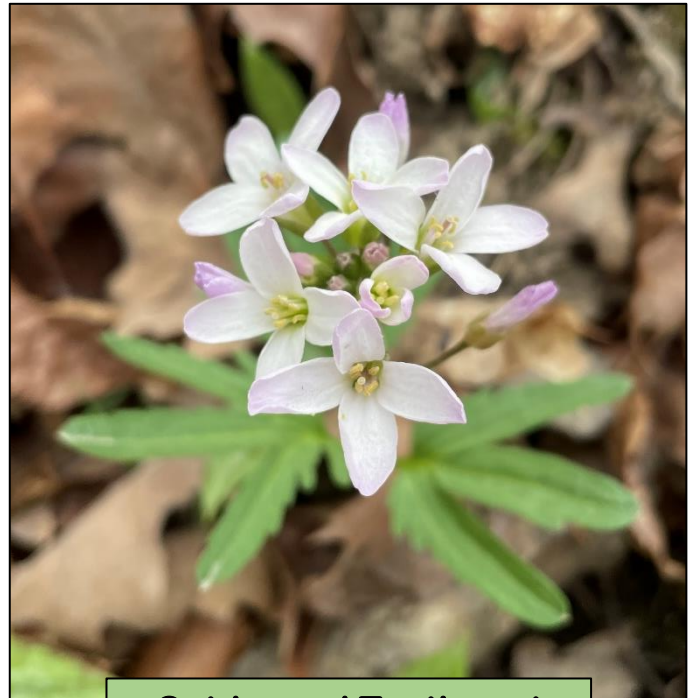
**Sharp-lobed Hepatica**
